TIERED RAFFLE

- 3-tier raffle – BLUE table >\$150 / RED table ~\$75 / YELLOW table ~\$35
- 200 ticket booklets printed (9 single tickets per book, 3 of each colour BLUE-RED-YELLOW)
- Booklet cost - \$60each or two for \$100 – cash or cheque accepted
- purchasers contacted information will be collected on a numbered sheet by volunteer manning the raffle tables
- winning tickets will be drawn during live auction – yellow table – live auction items – red table – live auction items – blue table
- winner must be present to claim prize. If not in attendance, a new ticket will be drawn until someone is present with correct ticket stub to claim prize. Items valued over \$100 will need signed for.

DRAW-A-BRUSH RAFFLE

- participants will pay \$10 to draw-a-brush
- 51 long handled paintbrushes will be placed, bristle side-up, in a clean silver paintcan filled with corks. Each brush handle(hidden) is marked with one, two, or three stripes.
- The participant will win the corresponding number of ticket stirps to bid with at the orange (draw-a-brush) table
- *Orange* table will be placed next to cash bar and winners will be called between main course and dessert ~7:30pm

Another note on the raffles – each table item will have a large clear jar / small paint can placed in front of it. Participants will place the corresponding coloured ticket(s) into the jar / can of the item(s) they would like to bid on . Each item and its jar /can will be tagged with coloured/numbered tag. Later in the evening, the winners will be chosen from the jar /can (the participant will need to be present to claim their prize – number will be called three times... no claim, another ticket will be drawn). Winning ticket will be marked and saved , and a ‘runner’ will bring the item to the winner at their table (value >\$100 requires signature).

Prices / Numbers:

- 124 event tickets printed - \$60each or two for \$100. Ticket price covers meal, entertainment, admittance to raffles and auction.
- draw-a-brush raffle – 90 booklets printed (winning brushes – 25 one booklet, 13 two booklet, 13 three booklet = 51 brushes) \$10 per play.
- door prize, one door prize drawn from event ticket stub.
